2. The abstract complies with the number of words (250), explains what the essay is about, the subject matter, the analysis performed and the main conclusion. It is translated into another language.

1.1. It reflects the contents of the essay.

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2. Development of the topic: proposal and argumentation

2.1. It deals with new or underdeveloped topics in the field of educational sciences.					
2.2. It shows mastery and depth in the theoretical and conceptual aspects addressed.					
2.3. It includes the contributions of the main theories, authors and/or paradigms related to the topic covered in the essay.					
2.4. There is a balance and coherence between the ideas presented, the theoretical positions and the position of the author.					
2.5. The discourse is fluent, clear and the arguments are theoretically supported.					
2.6. Bibliographic citations are included to support the argumentation.					
2.7. It complies with ethical standards throughout the document.

3.1. The conclusions are clear and consistent with the content developed in the essay in the introduction and the theoretical arguments.					
3.2. It provides new empirical or theoretical evidence in the field of educational sciences.					
3.3. It offers input for the development of new work in the field of educational sciences.

4. Format/Structure/Editing and Spelling

4.1. In-text citations and references are presented in accordance with APA standards, seventh edition 2020.					
4.2. The reference list has been constructed in accordance with APA standards, seventh edition 2020, and shows only the sources referenced within the text.					
4.3. The way ideas are organized in the document contributes to its uniqueness.					
4.4. The wording of the document allows for easy comprehension of ideas and fluency in its reading.					
4.5. There is no suspicion of plagiarism in any of its parts.
